From April 2012 we are pleased to announce that the Great Bed will be returning home to Ware on a one year loan from the Victoria and Albert Museum.

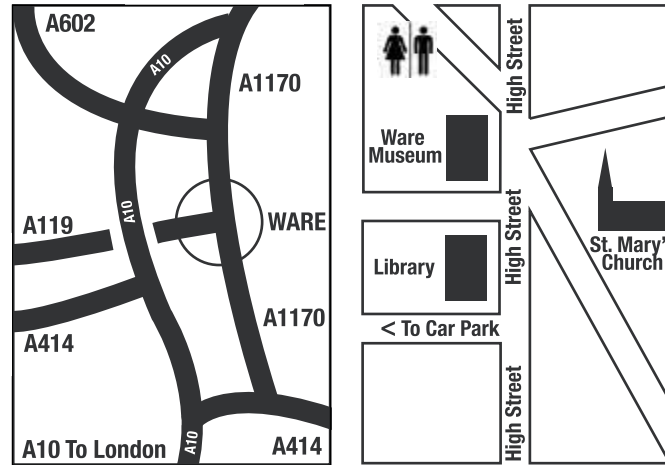
This exciting project has been made possible by a lot of hard work and a grant from the Heritage Lottery Fund.
